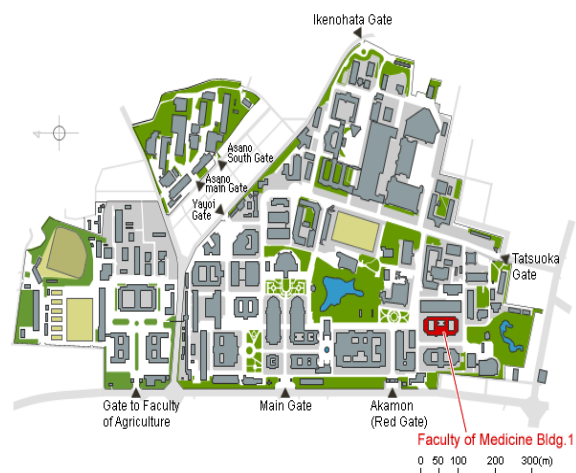

## About the Speaker

Dr. Flavell is a world's leader of immunology. His original work includes the first generation of a site-specific mutation in a phage genome and discovery of introns in cellular genes. More recently, he established the connection between inflammasomes, microbial homeostasis and chronic diseases. Dr. Flavell is a fellow of the Royal Society, a member of the National Academy of Sciences as well as the Institute of Medicine (USA) and received numerous prestigious awards.
