### Scope

 Support of young scientists in innovative research on the interrelation of structure and function in glaucoma

#### The requirements for an application for this award are:

First- or second author in a publication which is accepted for presentation at the 23<sup>rd</sup> International Visual Field and Imaging Symposium in Kanazawa, Japan.

- Responsibility for the scientific content of the publication.
- Innovative work judged of outstanding quality in the area of the relationship between morphology and function as relevant to the IPS
- Membership in good standing in the IPS
- Maximum age 40 years or less in the year of the IPS Symposium.

#### The award will be announced and presented at the IPS Banquet during the meeting.

The sponsor may decide to divide the award to more than one winner.

The results of the award are final and no appeal is permitted.

In order to consider your application, we must receive in electronic format:

- The completed IPS Heidelberg Award application form
- A curriculum vitæ (2 page)
- An abstract of the proposed presentation (1 page maximum)
